# Moxie's Reading Recap

#### Words to Know

- Clean Water: Water that has been cleaned at AlexRenew's Water Cleaning Facility to be returned to the Potomac River
- Dirty Water: The Water that you (and everyone in Alexandria) flushes down the toilet, drips down the shower, or swirls down the sink
- Rainwater: The Water that falls from the sky during a rain, hail, or snow storm
- TBM: Short for "Tunnel Boring Machine," a big piece of equipment used to dig tunnels underground
- Water Cleaning Facility: AlexRenew's wastewater treatment plant, which uses processes, equipment, and people to clean dirty water every day from all over the city

#### Wildlife Common to Our Watershed

- Barn Swallow: A small species of bird that nests and feeds near water bodies like the Potomac River
- Diamondback Terrapin: A species of turtle that lives in rivers and streams on the East Coast, like the Potomac River and Hunting Creek
- Largemouth Bass: A species of fish that lives in the Potomac River and other waterways across Virginia

## What's Under Your Feet in Alexandria?

Fill: The top layer of soil, like what you see when you dig in a garden

Alluvium: A loosely packed layer left behind by flowing water

Terrace: The third layer of soil, filled with big boulders

Potomac Clay: A TBM's favorite layer of soil, stiff and holds its shape

Potomac Sands: A deep soil layer full of dense, crumbly sand


## How the Tunnel Helps Alexandria's Waterways

When it rains in Old Town Alexandria, the **rainwater** flows down storm drains and into underground pipes like the ones you saw on Moxie's whiteboard.

Those pipes also carry dirty water that leaves homes and businesses in the neighborhood. When all this water mixes together, it becomes too much for the pipes to handle. When the pipes are full, not all of the dirty water mixed with rainwater can get to AlexRenew for cleaning. Instead, it overflows into Alexandria's rivers and streams through four outfalls in the Old Town area of the city.

To help fix this problem, AlexRenew is building the RiverRenew tunnel and other infrastructure, the biggest project of its kind in Alexandria's history. When RiverRenew is complete, Cloe's tunnel will bring more dirty water mixed with rainwater to AlexRenew for cleaning than ever before!

This will make Alexandria's rivers and streams cleaner and healthier so the animals, plants, and people who live here can be happier and healthier, too.
